Biography: Prof. Mazierska is an IEEE Fellow and currently a Head of the Institute of Information Sciences and Technology at Massey University in New Zealand. She received MSEE and PhD (1979) in Electronic Engineering from the Warsaw University of Technology, Poland. From 1972 till 1982 she worked with the Institute of Electronic Fundamentals, Warsaw University of Technology specializing in modeling of fast Semiconductor Devices for Computer-Aided-Design of Pulse and Microwave circuits. She spent the next four years on an assignment to the University of Jos, Department of Physics, Nigeria. In 1987 she joined the Electrical and Computer Engineering, School of Engineering in James Cook University. Her current research interests are microwave properties of High Temperature Superconductors and applications of HTS materials to Cellular and PCS communication systems. She was a Stanford University Visiting Scholar (Ginzton Laboratory) in 1991 and 1996.
